CITY of POWELL Snow and Sand Operations:

City of Powell Snow Plowing Operations:

It is the City of Powell's policy to plow / remove snow after an accumulation of four (4) inches or more of snow.

Like sanding, such plowing is limited to normal workweek hours, except for time of severe weather conditions which create a life-threatening emergency.

During major snowstorms, snow removal operations will concentrate on keeping the main traveled arteries open during normal school/work hours.

Snow removal operations will not be conducted between the hours of 9:00 pm and 4:00 am for any reason with the exception of a life-threatening emergency requiring plowing for emergency vehicle access as directed by emergency services.

During severe storms (storm conditions which threaten life and property of the public or response personnel and equipment), the City may **suspend** snow removal operations with the exception of emergency responses requiring plowing for emergency vehicle access as directed by emergency services.

City of Powell Snow Sanding Operations:

Snow sanding operations are limited to normal workweek hours except for time of severe weather conditions which create a life-threatening emergency. After hours, Weekends and Holidays may be called out by Emergency Services.

Sanding operations will not be conducted between the hours of 9:00 pm and 4:00 am for any reason with the exception of a life-threatening emergency. Exceptions to this will be determined by Emergency Services, the Streets Superintendent or designated operator(s).

During severe storms (storm conditions which threaten life and property of the public or response personnel and equipment), the City may **suspend** snow sanding operations with the exception of emergency responses as directed by Emergency Services, the Streets Superintendent or designated operator(s).
