

RESOLUTION 7, 2018

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell needs to amend the 2018-2019 budget to provide for the appropriation of unappropriated surplus funds.

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing on such amendment was published in the Powell Tribune on July 6, 2018.

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on such amendment at a time and place specified in said notice at which time all interested parties were given the opportunity to be heard.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF POWELL, WYOMING, AS FOLLOWS:

General Fund is increased by the sum of \$50,000; the source of which will be unappropriated surplus funds. \$15,000 will be used for the purchase of the street sweeper that was originally budgeted with a trade-in which can no longer be done since it was involved in an accident and \$35,000 will be used the purchase of a police car that was not completed last fiscal year due to a delay by the manufacturer.

Sewer Fund is increased by the sum of \$15,000 for the additional cost of the street sweeper; the source of which will be unappropriated surplus funds.

The above and foregoing resolution was adopted by the governing body of the City of Powell, Wyoming on the 16<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2018.
